RE: Preliminary Notice to the Junior Men's Athlete Selection Procedures for the 2025 Junior Pan American Games

To provide as much information in a timely manner, USA Field Hockey is releasing this Preliminary Notice to the Junior Men's Athlete Selection Procedures for the 2025 Junior Pan American Games (August 9-23, 2025). This document is being written as a complement, and not a substitute to the 2025 Junior Pan American Games Athlete Selection Procedures.

At this time, USA Field Hockey has determined that it will participate in the 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

A. Anticipated Evaluation Events:

- It is intended that athletes being considered for nomination to the 2025 Junior Pan American Games will be evaluated on their performance at 2024-25 USA Field Hockey U18 and U21 Junior Men's National Team (JMNT) Training Camps and Matches.

- Participation in all USA Field Hockey U18 and U21 JMNT 2025 Training Camps and Matches (including the Cal Cup) will be by invitation only. Additional information will be sent to invited athletes at least thirty (30) days prior to each camp session.
- Athletes that have been invited to participate in USA Field Hockey U18 and U21 JMNT Training Camps and Matches were identified at the 2024-25 Junior USMNT Talent Identification and Training Camp.
- Athletes who were not invited to participate in USA Field Hockey U18 and U21 JMNT Training Camps through the 2024-25 Junior USMNT Talent Identification and Training Camp may submit an application to the USA Field Hockey Junior High Performance Staff to be evaluated for a possible invitation.
 - In order to be considered, athletes must submit a resume and video via email to Kathy Schiller, USA Field Hockey Men's National Team Manager, via email (kschiller@usafielddhockey.com), and Pat Harris, USA Field Hockey U21 JMNT Head Coach (pharris@usafielddhockey.com).

Resume submission should outline the Athlete's participation history and current level of engagement within the sport of Field Hockey, specifying both the frequency and level of competition (e.g. high school, college, club, etc...).



Video footage should be from within the immediately preceding six months from the time of submission and may include both game and/or training footage.

- As the evaluation of athlete applications, and possible invitations to U18 and U21 JMNT Training Camps, will be an ongoing process, athletes are encouraged to apply as early as possible. Applications will no longer be considered after May 10, 2025.
- After evaluation of submitted materials, athletes will be contacted via email if they have been selected to participate in a USA Field Hockey JMNT Training camp for further evaluation.
