


I. **PURPOSE**

I-A. Forza Weightlifting Club is requesting to host the 2022 Illinois State Weightlifting Championships. We have the resources and experience to conduct an outstanding event that will benefit the weightlifting competitors in the State of Illinois

II. **FACILITY**

II-A. The 2022 Illinois State Weightlifting Championships would be hosted at 1033 Progress Drive in Grayslake, Illinois. We have hosted multiple events at this facility, which were well attended and successful.





II-B. Forza Weightlifting Club hall has a 10,000 sq ft facility including a locker room, bathrooms, competition area, 13 warm up platforms, among other amenities.

II-C. Bathrooms and showers are located in the north west corner of the gym.



II-D. Forza Weightlifting Club has parking available to accommodate all competitors, coaches, volunteers, and spectators in a parking lot as well as supplemental street parking.



II-E. Hotel accommodations are available at the Comfort Suites Libertyville North approximately 5 minutes from the venue.



III. MEET FORMAT

The 2022 Illinois State Weightlifting Championships will run as a one-platform two day meet. The details about the meet format are as follows:

III-A. 13 warm up platforms will be provided.

III-B. There will be 4-5 sessions per day that can accommodate a minimum of 120 lifters. The final number of participants for this event will be decided in collaboration with the IL WSO board.

III-C. The entry fee for this meet will be \$75 per lifter. This price was determined based on the size and importance of the Illinois State Championship meet.

III-D. The funds from this meet will be held in a bank account dedicated to holding meet funds. Should the event be canceled Forza Weightlifting Club agrees to have all refunds released within two weeks of official cancellation.

III-E. Adequate kilo weights, including change plates, will be provided for all warm up platforms.

III-F. IWF certified Eleiko weights will be used for the competition platforms.

III-G. Medals would be provided to all 1st-3rd place finishes. Trophies or banners will be awarded to the best female and male lifters in the youth, junior, open, and masters divisions. There would also be 1st-3rd place trophies or banners for teams who enter.

III-H. All USAW/IWF rules and weight classes are observed at this meet.

IV. TIMELINE

We will hold the 2022 Illinois State Weightlifting Championships the weekend of May 21-22, 2022.

V. <u>MEET/SCHOOL LOCATION</u>

Forza Weightlifting Club is located at 1033 Progress Drive, Grayslake, Illinois 60030.

VI. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

Forza Weightlifting Club would love the opportunity to host the 2022 Illinois State Championship because we feel we can offer a well-run meet that will benefit the weightlifting competitors of Illinois.
