ELIGIBILITY: USATT membership required. Open to residents of Alabama including Students and Military stationed in the state. **Players must provide proof of current membership or purchase basic membership to participate** (available on this form).

FORMAT: Championship and U-1500 Singles events will be round robin in the first round with ALL players advancing to a single-elimination playoff.

FIRST ROUND: Players will be grouped in 4's or 5's using "snake" system in accordance with USATT Tournament Guide. **Playoffs:** Top two players from each group in the Championship Singles will advance to Championship. All others will advance to Class A.

In the U-1500 Singles, the top two players for each group will advance to Class B. The remaining players will advance to Class C.

Players may not enter both Championship and Under-1500 RR singles events, may enter only one doubles event and only enter one Seniors or Esquires event.

Seniors, Esquires, Juniors and Women will be RR with group size depending on number of participants.

*Doubles events will be single elimination. **Deadline to sign up for doubles is noon on tournament day, \$8 per player for doubles events.**

All finals will be the best 3 out of 5 games w/ the exception of championship singles, which will be 4 out of 7 games.

SCHEDULE: Championship and U-1500 RR Singles play starts at 9 a.m.

Seniors, Esquires, Juniors, Women may begin no sooner than 2 p.m. Doubles will begin at 3 p.m. Players must register no later than **30 minutes prior** to starting time. Players not on time may be defaulted.

ENTRY BLANK TEMPLATE FOR USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have **regular contact with or authority over** minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport>.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) who have **regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
