CODE OF CONDUCT

NATIONAL COACH

I understand that as a **USA Karate National Coach**, I have assumed certain responsibilities to prepare, develop and be an advocate for the USA Athletes in the Sport of Karate. To that end of successfully fulfilling my role, I agree to:

- 1. Obey and abide by all USA-NKF published rules, regulations, protocols and procedures.
- 2. Be familiar with and obey all WKF Rules of Competition and regulations pertaining to coaching.
- 3. Maintain exemplary standards of personal conduct.
- 4. Maintain a professional appearance, including my personal attire, while representing USA-NKF while coaching or at other official appearances.
- 5. Obey all State, National and International Laws.
- 6. Follow the rules and policies of the US Center for Safe Sport.
- 7. Follow the rules and policies related to Coaches set forth by the US Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) and the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).
- 8. Not use alcohol, illegal drugs or substances, to an extent which could impair or hamper my best judgment or abilities as a Coach.
- 9. Apprise myself of all organizational duties and ensure that those duties are carried out in a timely and professional manner.
- 10. Attend all mandatory USA-NKF Technical/Referee Clinics/Seminars and social events required of me.
- 11. Refrain from using any profane or abusive language.
- 12. Accept no gratuities or gifts from Athlete members.

- 13. Refrain from fraternizing with Athletes in an inappropriate manner, and to be constantly aware of the power imbalance between a coach and athlete even in social settings.
- 14. Not coach, train or work with athletes from competing National Teams while on official trips or in my role as a USA National Coach.
- 15. Assume any disciplinary measures or penalties imposed by the USA-NKF for the following:
 - a) Not property registering Athletes for events or categories, which result in disqualification.
 - b) Not properly ensuring Athletes are apprised of any rule changes or other regulations related to the Field of Play, which could adversely affect their performance.
 - c) Not properly tabulating score or placement, which affects the final results of an Athletes competition.
 - d) Neglecting to coach/support an athlete that you have been assigned or responsible for during a competition
 - e) Arbitrarily/Improperly withdrawing a Contestant or Team
 - f) Not issuing a formal protest where one could affect the ultimate outcome of a match on behalf of an Athlete because of a lack of attention, concern or knowledge of the rules.
- 16. Do my utmost to teach and support each Athlete fairly and equitably.
- 17. Do my utmost to use my experience to ensure the best Athlete representation on behalf of the United States.
- 18. I will not discriminate against any part of the Delegation or Athletes based upon race, sex, gender, sexual orientation or National origin.

- 19. I will not speak disparaging of the Federation or my colleagues and will endeavor to promote the National Governing Body in a positive way.
- 20. As a USA-NKF Coach, I will not make comments or posts on social media which are negative or disparaging about any USA-NKF athlete, fellow coach or USA-NKF official.
- 21. I will remember that my professional conduct includes during the use of social media and public statements.
- 22. I understand no USA National Team Tracksuit or uniform may be worn while coaching domestically unless I am coaching in my capacity as a National Coach representing USA in international competition.
