Preliminary Notice to Potential Participation in World Aquatics Recognized Events

USA Diving is committed to providing its members with timely updates regarding international competition opportunities. This notice serves as a preliminary communication regarding potential participation in World Aquatics Recognized Events occurring prior to the 2025 USA Diving Nationals.

Our participation in these events is contingent upon final approval of the 2025 funding allocation and budget. Once funding decisions are finalized, USA Diving will provide an updated notice confirming which events we plan to attend and the corresponding selection criteria for team participation.

Anticipated Eligibility Criteria for Team Participation

Athletes who may be selected for participation in the World Aquatics Recognized Events must meet the following requirements:

- Be a citizen of the United States and a member in good standing with USA Diving.
- Meet the age requirements as determined by World Aquatics. Divers younger than 14 years old on December 31, 2025, shall not be permitted to compete.
- Hold a valid U.S. passport that will not expire for six months after the conclusion of the selected event(s).
- Abide by all USA Diving, USADA, USOPC, WADA, and World Aquatics anti-doping policies.
- Meet all eligibility and competition requirements as outlined by World Aquatics for Recognized Events.

 Maintain compliance with USA Diving's Athlete Safety Policy and complete all required background screening and training (if applicable).

Potential Events Under Consideration

Pending budget approval, USA Diving is considering attending the following World Aquatics Recognized Events in January – April 2025:

Event Name	Date	Location
Southern Cross Diving Series – Leg 1	January 31 - February 2, 2025	Auckland, New Zealand
Southern Cross Diving Series – Leg 2	February 7- 9, 2025	Gold Coast, Australia

Note: This list is subject to change based on funding approval, event scheduling updates, and strategic planning priorities.

Selection Criteria

If participation in any of these events is confirmed, selection criteria will prioritize:

- Results from recent USA Diving domestic events, such as the 2024 Winter Nationals.
- Athlete availability and readiness for competition as determined by USA Diving High Performance staff.
- Performance at prior World Aquatics Recognized Events or international competitions.

Details regarding the specific selection process will be outlined in future communications once funding and event participation decisions are finalized.

Future Selection Events for World Aquatics Recognized Events

Selections for the following events will be based on results from the 2025 USA Diving Nationals (dates and location TBD):

- Canada Cup
- American Cup
- Bolzano Diving Meeting

Athletes aiming to compete in these World Aquatics Recognized Events are encouraged to prioritize performance at the 2025 USA Diving Nationals, as this will serve as the primary evaluation opportunity.

Details regarding the specific selection process will be outlined in future communications once funding and event participation decisions are finalized.
