

# 2026 USA DIVING ZONE CHAMPIONSHIPS BID INFORMATION

#### **EVENT OVERVIEW**

The USA Diving Zone Championship events serve as qualifying competitions for the USA Diving Junior National Championships. Divers will contend for qualifying spots on 1-meter, 3-meter and platform individual events. USA Diving is accepting bids from interested hosts for 2026.

This event will be awarded to six different sites – one site within each geographic Zone (<u>click here for map</u>). USA Diving is seeking hosts with the capability of hosting a large number of athletes, coaches and officials, as well as a facility that meets World Aquatics regulations and standards for the aforementioned events. Facilities with dryland training opportunities will be preferred.

## **DATES OF FACILITY USE / COMPETITION**

The USA Diving Zone Championships are held over three or four competition days depending on the number of simultaneous events that can be run. An event schedule will be provided to hosts by the National Office.

<u>Bids must be submitted to the USA Diving national office by September 12, 2025.</u> Bids must include a fully completed bid application, photographs of the venue inside and outside and a cover letter. USA Diving reserves the sole right to extend the deadline pending acceptable review of bid submissions.
