Application Requirements - Applicants must:

- be at least 18 years of age and a current Active member of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports (USA-WSWS)
- comply with and meet all requirements for boater's training and/or licensing under state law applicable in the driver's state of residence
- Always have a current and valid motor vehicle operator's license while they hold an NSSA driver's rating (or, in the case of a rated driver who does not currently hold a motor vehicle operator's license, demonstrate that the reason that he/she does not currently hold this license is not because his/her motor vehicle operator's license privileges have been suspended or revoked)
- immediately report to USA-WSWS any suspension or loss of their motor vehicle operator's license
- meet minimum "safe driving" standards established by NSSA at all times
- hold a current NSSA Class A Driver's rating prior to applying for a Class B Learner's Permit or hold a current NSSA Class B Driver's rating prior to applying for a Class C Learner's Permit (a waiver request may be submitted in writing to the NSSA Drivers' Committee when a team does not have a specific boat related to each rating)

Application Instructions

- Complete the application in full, sign where indicated, and return to USA-WSWS Officials' Program Coordinator. Be sure to retain a copy of the application for your records.
- Upon application approval, a NSSA Tested Driver Learner's Permit will be issued for the classification requested which allows the permit holder to operate the applicable class towboat in USA-WSWS sanctioned club practices/ski show exhibitions and USA-WSWS/NSSA-sanctioned tournaments.

Class B and C Learner's Permits are valid for two years from the date of issue at which time the permit expires. If the driver does not complete the Class B or C Driver on-water practical evaluation to advance to a Class B or C Driver before the permit expires, the driver can request a renewal of the permit by driving a USA-WSWS/NSSA-sanctioned show ski tournament or driving ten hours of USA-WSWS sanctioned show ski club practices/exhibitions each of the last two years.
