Two 1M and two 3M Duraflex Model B springboards on Durafirm short stands. One 1M Duraflex Model B springboard on A-frame. Stacked 1M, 3M, 5M, 7.5M platforms and a free standing 10M platform with RoughTex. Replay system and showers available. Water depth is 17 feet at deepest point with sprayers for surface agitation. Dryboard and trampoline may be used under coach supervision only.

RESTAURANTS, GIFT IDEAS & ACTIVITIES

1. The Harvey House – Hidden behind Madison’s Historic Train Depot, The Harvey House is a celebration of Wisconsin’s iconic supper clubs.
2. The Old Fashioned – A Madison staple and the best cheese curds in town. Great Wisconsin cuisine with a prime view of the Downtown Square.
3. The Boathouse– Located at lake level in the historic Langdon Building, The Boathouse serves authentic Wisconsin favorites like a Chicken BLT on Stella’s Spicy Cheese Bread —all with beautiful Lake Mendota as its front yard.
4. Coopers Tavern – Similar to The Old Fashioned in a little cozier environment. It may be a debate among locals of which is better between the two. With great food, friendly people, and a view of the capitol you can’t go wrong.
5. Lucille – Great pizza in a remodeled bank building with a view of the capital. One of the newer restaurants in Madison and it has quickly become one of the best.
6. Mickey's Dairy Bar – A badger alumni staple. Hearty portions and breakfast milkshakes. Boasts a breakfast scrambler so big that even a hungry athlete will struggle to clean their plate.
7. Gate’s & Brovi – Take a drive or Uber down charming Monroe Street to this modern Wisco Tavern. Cheese curds, chicken picatta and the spicy chicken sandwich are all highly recommended.
8. The Edgewater Hotel – Enjoy some great food with amazing views of Lake Mendota. The Statesider Restaurant offer an upscale menu or you can venture down to the Boat House for a more casual setting.
9. Dotty Dumpling’s Dowry – Dotty’s arguably serves some of the best burgers in Madison. The décor inside gives it a comfortable feel and it is conveniently located near campus.
10. Eno Vino – Sleek spot with floor-to-ceiling windows & dramatic Capitol views for tapas, craft cocktails & wine.
11. Chocolate Shoppe – A walk down State Street is always better with an ice cream cone in hand. The Chocolate Shoppe serves some of the best scoops in the country (this is the dairy state) and makes for a great after dinner dessert.
12. Fromagination – Founded in 2007 by owner and Creative Director Ken Monteleone, who believes that Wisconsin cheese, the Badger State's cheese-making heritage, and its growing artisan food movement all deserve a showcase. Fantastic gift ideas to take a piece of Madison home.
13. *The Terrace* – A trip to Madison would not be complete without a visit to the terrace. One of the most beloved places in the city to catch up with friends, grab a brat, and soak in the scenery right on Lake Mendota.
14. *Monroe Street* – With over 1-1/2 miles of locally-owned businesses, Monroe Street is bordered by a beautiful historic neighborhood and conveniently located near UW Madison's Camp Randall Stadium and connecting to Lake Wingra. If you want to get out on the water rent kayaks, SUP boards, and paddle boats at Wingra Boats located in Wingra Park.
15. *B-Cycle* - Rent an E-Bike at one of the dozens of bike racks and explore one of the nations most bike friendly cities. It's a great way to tour our city and get the best lake views.
16. *UW Arboretum* – Widely recognized as the site of historic research in ecological restoration. Take a beautiful fall hike or drive through the 1200 acres of the oldest and most varied collection of restored ecological communities in the world.
17. *Henry Vilas Zoo* – One of only a handful of admission-free, community-supported zoos in the country. Fully accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums, our beautiful zoo features exhibits and attractions for the whole family!
18. Farmers Market on the Square – Patrons will find a full array of Wisconsin fruits and vegetables, cheeses, honey and maple syrups, local meats, bakery items, and many specialty items. We highly recommend some fresh cheese curds and Stella's Spicy Cheese Bread.
