Submission Guidelines

Global Meet the Experts:

A Global Meet the Experts session will take place within the Global Rheumatology Summit and will focus on **Multisystem Inflammatory Syndromes in Children (IgG4-RD, HLH, MAS, SJIA)**. Cases will be submitted in advance from around the world, and leading rheumatology experts will discuss and debate key questions and learning points arising from these cases.

Submit your diagnostically challenging case of **Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (IgG4-RD, HLH, MAS, SJIA)** or a case that has a difficult/refractory management course.

The review committee will select up to four cases based on teaching value for inclusion. If your case is accepted, you will be supported to pre-record a 5-minute presentation with the ACR team and will receive complimentary registration to ACR Convergence 2025.

- You may submit up to two cases.
 - Each case must be submitted in PowerPoint format.
 - Cases must not be more than six slides and must follow this format:
 - Slide 1: Title slide – Please include the case title. The case title should be intriguing and make the reader curious. The title should not disclose the diagnosis.
 - Slide 2: Introduction to the case
 - Slide 3-4: Provide a clinical overview of the case
 - Slide 5: State diagnostic or therapeutic dilemma
 - Slide 6: Include questions for the experts
