

PERCENT SENSITIVITY AND SPECIFICITY OF VARIOUS CRITERIA FOR TYPICAL REITER'S SYNDROME

Method of Classification	Sensitivity	Specificity
1. Episode of arthritis of more than 1 month with urethritis and/or cervicitis	(84.3%) (70/83)	(98.2%) (163/166)
3. Episode of arthritis, conjunctivitis, and urethritis	(50.6%) (42/83)	(98.8%) (164/166)

* Initial episode.

+ Numbers in parenthesis indicate number of patients correctly classified/number tested.
