Live Virtual Symposium Session | June 12, 2026

The 45 minute live symposium session is designed to balance expert instruction, sponsor engagement, and interactive discussion.

Session format:

- 10–15 minutes: Sponsor recorded educational talks (3–5 minutes each), aligned with the session topic and approved by the session speaker
- 10–15 minutes: Live, moderated Q&A with faculty, sponsors, and attendees
- Sponsors participate both through **pre recorded content**, and **real time engagement** during the live Q&A.

Featured Topic: High Yield Skin Findings in Rheumatology for New APPs
