



## NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION

Construction of the new vacuum sewer pump station located next to Gibsonton Elementary School is scheduled to begin in January 2026. The pump station is being built on an easement provided by the Hillsborough County School Board at the southern end of the school, adjacent to Nundy Avenue. The vacuum sewer pump station will serve as the centralized collection point and power source for the vacuum sewer system. Construction is anticipated to be completed in late 2027. *(See below for construction impacts and pump station details.)*

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Typical construction noise during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.



Intermittent lane closures and flagging operations on Nundy Avenue.



Construction material deliveries using the Nundy Avenue entrance.



No anticipated traffic impacts on Gibsonton Drive.

### GIBSONTON PUMP STATION FEATURES



Pump station access will be from Nundy Avenue.



The pump station facility will be gated and secured with fencing.



The chain link fence along Nundy Avenue will be replaced with a new fence.



The wastewater pumps will be completely enclosed in a concrete building that will insulate and minimize noise.



The pump station is designed to blend into the surrounding community.



An advanced odor control system will be included to prevent potential sewer odors.
