❖ **Graph 2: Nonprofit Funding Since FY 1998**

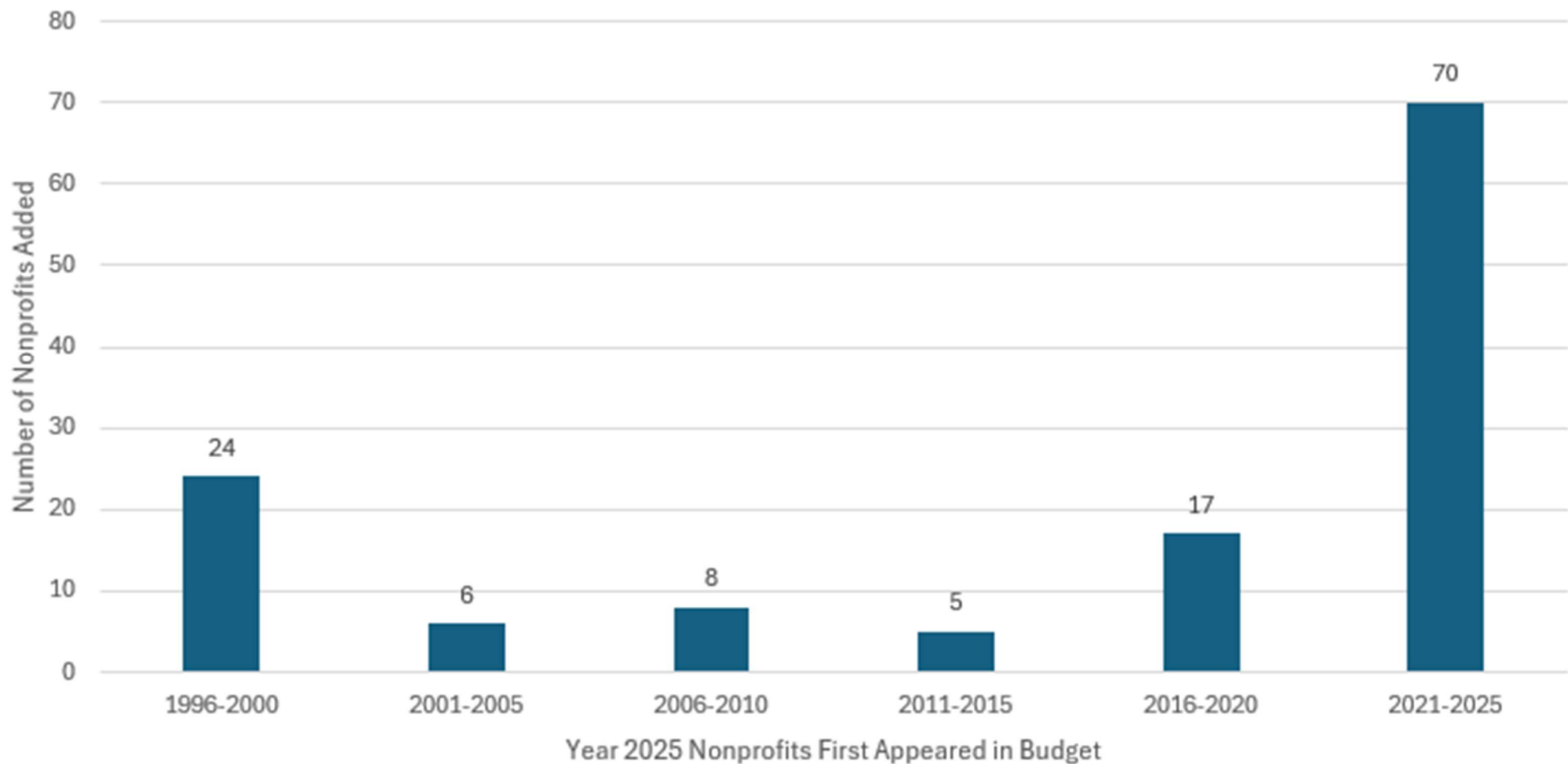

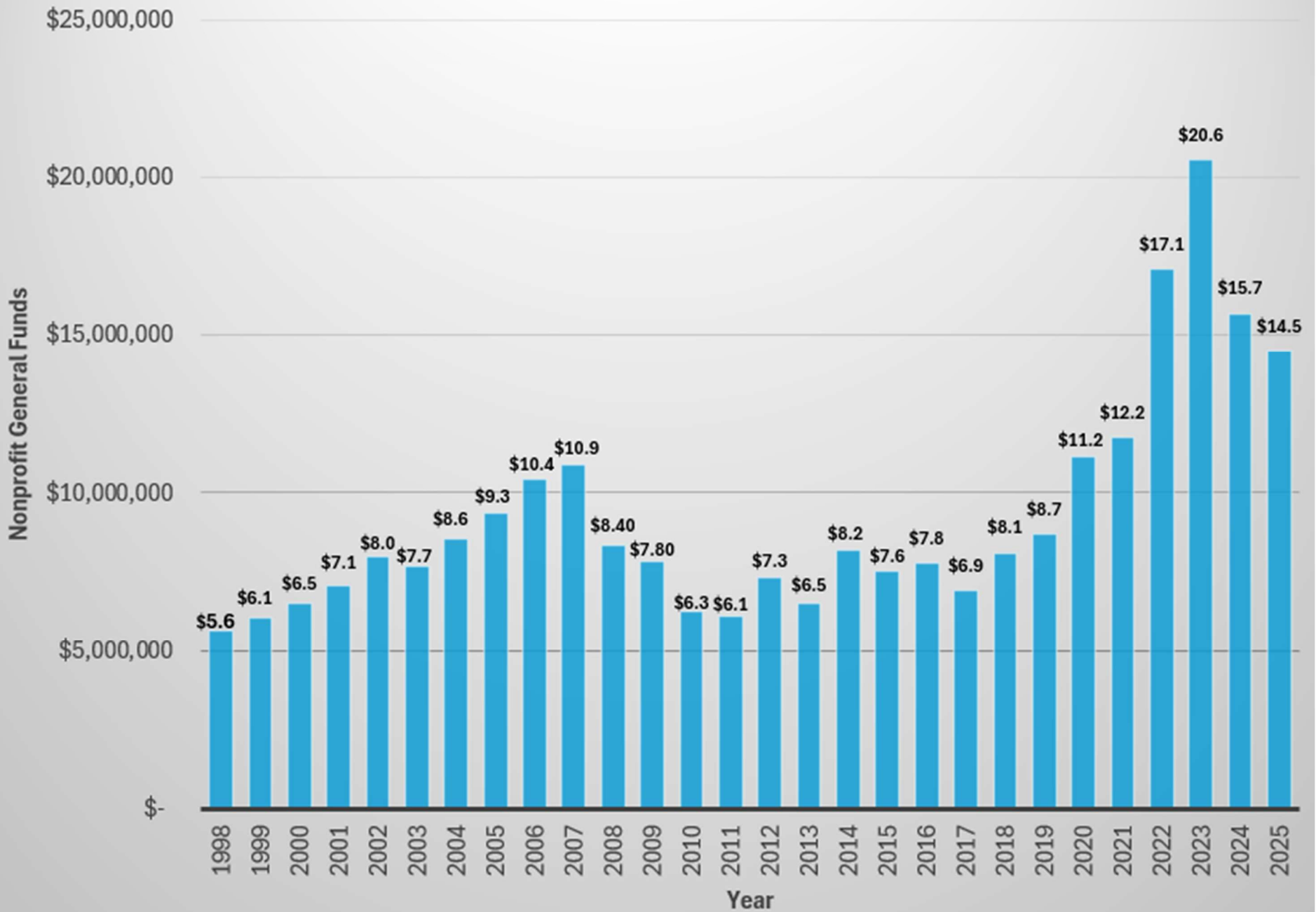
Graph 1:
