7. The Waste Water billing shall commence two weeks after your tank is installed.

- 8. The estimated tank installation shall occur once the applicant completed the items below:
 - a. The applicant's completion and submission of the signed and Notarized form (and)
 - b. The payment of all impact and connections fees to the Utility.
 - c. The completion of site visit and customer approved tank site location.
 - d. The applicant notifies the County that the new home has the roof placed (or)
 - e. When the mobile home has been permanently placed on the parcel.

9. The final LPSS electrical inspection will take place once the system is connected to TECO power (*The certificate of occupancy cannot be obtained until final power is in place*)

10. The applicant shall not sub-divide the parcel and the parcel shall remain residential use.
