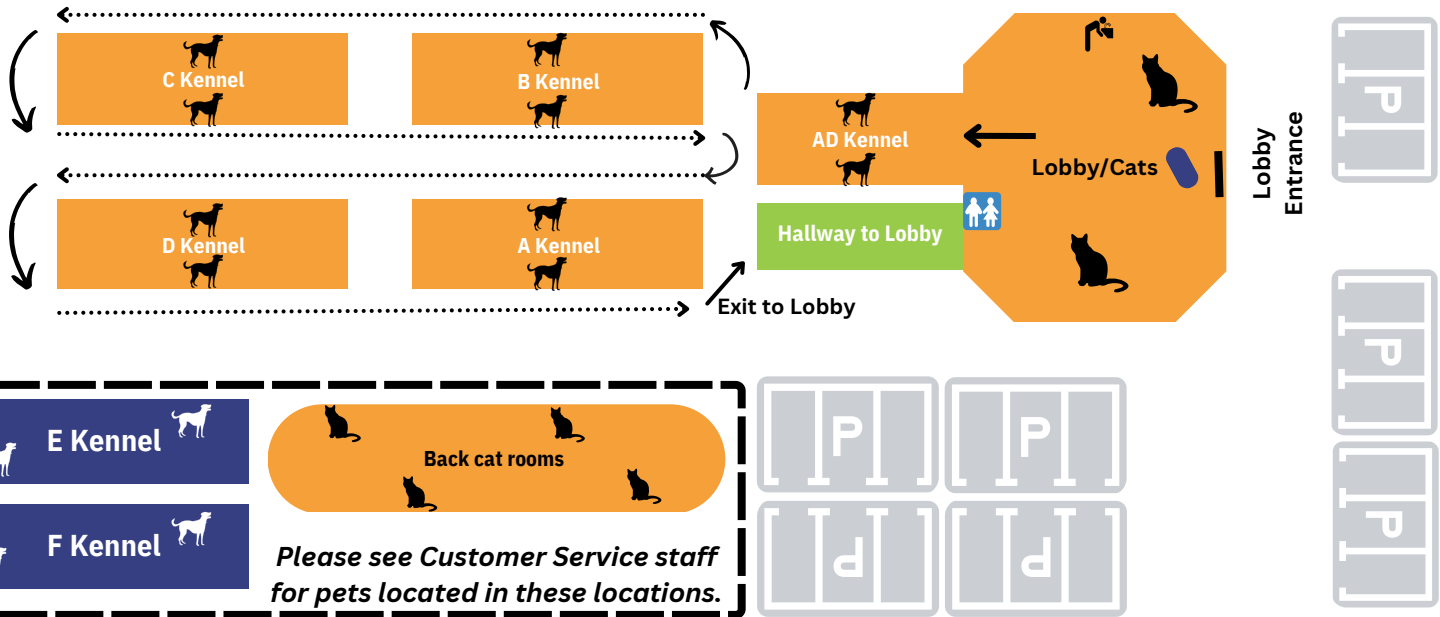

How to Adopt a Pet:

Find a pet:

- Locate the pet of your choice. Note the information provided by the kennel card. (see "Notes on kennel card" on this sheet)
- If you would like to meet the pet and spend a little time with it, take the kennel card up to the front desk by the front doors and a meet and greet will be called for.
 - Most pets will be available to spend some time with you. Certain pets that are on a hold may not be available to be met with but may be pre-adopted.
 - Pre-adoption reserves the pet for you; however, if an owner appears to reclaim their pet while still in our facility, we are required to return the pet to them. Funds expended can be held for you towards another pet of your choice or refunded thru the audit process via the Clerk of the Court (this usually takes 6-8 weeks.)

Notes on Kennel cards:

- **"B"** = the pet has a bite/scratch history. Further details can be provided by Customer Service staff.
- **"Stray"** = a pet was found loose and was picked up by a concerned citizen or Animal Control.
- **"OTC"** = this means over the counter. Usually connected with stray pets who were brought in by a concerned citizen.
- **Stamped "I'M ADOPTED"** = the pet has been pre-adopted and is no longer available for adoption.
- **RTG** = the pet is ready to go home with you today.
