### **Annual Passes**

 Annual entry passes are available for purchase online. Discounted annual entry passes are available for veterans, first responders, and law enforcement who live or work in Hillsborough County.

### **Park Rules**

- Dogs must be in handler's control at all times, and on a 6-foot or shorter, nonretractable leash.
- Horses must be in handler's control at all times, be bridled, saddled, and have a negative Coggins test result available upon request.
- No alcohol.
- No disruptive behavior.
- Piñatas, water balloons, and confetti are not permitted in the park to protect the environment and wildlife.

## About the park

Sydney Dover Conservation Park, located east of Brandon, features a popular 7.5-mile equestrian trail and is dry most of the year. The trail has changes in contour because of its history as a reclaimed phosphate mine. The trailhead has plenty of space for horse trailers, plus an informational kiosk and trail map. Please Note: Horseback riding rentals are not offered. Riders must bring their own horse.

The trail is located at 535 N. Dover Rd. Take Highway 60 to North Dover Road and turn north. Continue approximately half a mile to the parking area on the east side of the road.
