



### White Paper on Substance Use Disorders



On September 22, 2022, FAIR Health released a white paper that analyzed substance use disorders and overdoses prior to the COVID-19 pandemic as compared to during the pandemic

The analysis, which spanned from 2016 to 2021, covered trends in the percentage of patients with a substance use disorder or overdose diagnosis, as well as age, gender, incidence, relevant substances, states, preexisting mental health conditions, venues of care and provider specialties




# Patients with an Opioid Use Disorder Diagnosis, 2017-2022








## Median Age of Patients with Opioid Use Disorder Diagnoses, 2017-2022








#### Gender of Patients with Opioid Use Diagnosis, 2019-2022








### Opioid Use Disorder by Age and Gender, 2017-2022







# **Emergency Room Visits among Patients with an Opioid Use Disorder, 2017-2022**




#### Patients with an Opioid Overdose Diagnosis, 2017-2022








## Median Age of Patients with Opioid and Opioid-Like Overdoses, 2017-2022







# Gender of Patients with Opioid and Opioid-Like Overdoses, 2019-2022








# Opioid and Opioid-Like Overdoses, by Gender and Age, 2017-2022













### **Opioid vs. Fentanyl Overdoses, 2021-2022**






#### ER Visits among Opioid Overdose Patients, 2018-2022








## Hospitalizations among Opioid Overdose Patients, 2018-2022








## Opioid Overdoses among Opioid Use Disorder Patients, 2017-2022








Emergency department visit with moderate level of medical decision making




