- Spring/Summer: 8 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- Fall/Winter: 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.

## Fees Entry

- \$2 per vehicle up to eight people
- Swimming: \$2 per person

## Swimming area

- Time Slot #1: 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.
- Time Slot #2: 2 p.m. - 6 p.m.
- Sanitation of the swim area will occur in between the two time slots.
- Swim bands will not be sold one hour prior to swimming area closing.
- Note: Swimming area subject to close due to inclement weather.
- Children less than 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

## Camping Rates

- \$24 per night
- Senior Discounts: 55 and over, \$18 per night  
65 and over, \$12 per night (only for residents of Hillsborough County)

## Park Rules

- Pets must be in your control at all times, and on a 6-foot or shorter, non-retractable leash
- Pets are not allowed in the swim area
- No alcohol
- No disruptive behavior
- No Bluetooth or amplified devices
- Piñatas; water balloons, and egg confetti are not permitted in the park to protect the environment and wildlife



### About the park

Lithia Springs Conservation Park is a popular destination for campers, swimmers, and paddlers. Come explore the park's woody trails, and its diverse plant communities. Finish your adventure with a dip in the natural spring, which is the park's major attraction. The water is at a constant 72 degrees, providing a refreshing experience year-round. The park features 44 campsites which are suitable for RVs. Campers have access to picnic shelters with tables, and barbecue grills. Campground restrooms with showers, and an RV dump station are also available to registered campers. Campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
