



How To Keep Your Pets Stress-Free and Healthy During the Moving Process

Before the Move

- ☐ Schedule a veterinary appointment to make sure vaccinations are up to date and discuss how to make the move comfortable for your pet.
- ☐ Ask your vet whether you need a health certificate or Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for your destination.
- ☐ Request copies of vaccination records, prescriptions, microchip details, and your pet's full medical history.
- ☐ Research veterinarians near your new home and choose one before you move.
- ☐ Arrange for your current vet to transfer medical records to your new veterinary clinic if possible. If not, consider emailing records across before your first visit.
- ☐ Make sure your pet's tags and microchip registration include your new address and phone number.

On Moving Day

- ☐ Keep your pet in a quiet, secure room away from noise, movers, and open doors.
- ☐ Carry important pet documents with you.
- ☐ Pack familiar items such as food, toys, bedding, and treats to help your pet feel more comfortable.

After the Move

- ☐ Book an appointment with your new veterinarian soon after arriving.
- ☐ Bring your pet's vaccination history, medical records, medications, and any health certificates to the first appointment.
- ☐ Keep feeding, walking, and sleeping routines as consistent as possible while your pet adjusts.
- ☐ Watch for signs of stress, illness, or changes in behavior during the first few weeks.
