



Moving-Day Parking Checklist

Most parking arrangements come down to a handful of details at each address. This checklist can help you keep them together:

- ☐ Check the parking setup at both the pickup and delivery addresses.
- ☐ Confirm whether the mover or customer is handling any municipal permit.
- ☐ Ask what size truck is expected.
- ☐ Find out how much curb space the truck needs.
- ☐ Check city parking and loading-zone rules.
- ☐ Apply for any required temporary no-parking permit.
- ☐ Reserve the apartment or condo loading dock, if applicable.
- ☐ Reserve the freight elevator for the same moving window.
- ☐ Send the building's COI requirements to the mover.
- ☐ Check HOA moving and commercial-vehicle rules.
- ☐ Confirm any gate codes or security instructions.
- ☐ Ask about long-carry and shuttle charges if truck access is limited.
- ☐ Post permit signs within the timeframe required by the city.
- ☐ Reconfirm parking and building access with the mover a few days before the move.
- ☐ Clear your driveway or private parking area before the truck arrives.
- ☐ Check for temporary street restrictions or construction the day before.
